

Believe In God

We cannot see, hear, touch, smell or taste God. He cannot be demonstrated by scientific analysis. There are no pictures to which we can relate the presence or person of God. No medical procedure can present Him. He cannot be presented personally to an atheistic teacher in a classroom in an effort to forestall vindictive attacks.

The distinctive differences between an atheist, agnostic and the believer are how each pressures the available evidence. Denying the evidence gives the atheist reason for denial. Not being sure there is enough evidence is the agnostic platform. The believer takes the available evidence and irrefutable, credible proofs and testifies that there is a God. The evidence warrants that there is a God.

Living things cannot spontaneously exist without a giver of life. Lifeless matter cannot become a living thing. The law of Biogenesis [beginning of life] teaches life comes from previous life of its own kind. This law is unerring when it teaches that "life never arises except from life" [John Sullivan, atheist]. Spontaneous generation is disproved by Louis Pasteur's experiment with a bottle which had an "s" shaped neck. Until he broke the neck it remained uncontaminated. He and others proved that there was no spontaneous generation. Modern scientists have repeatedly proved that life comes from other life. "Every living thing on the planet had parents" [Neil Shubin -staunch evolutionist]. The information available to scientists now points to the fact that every living thing sprang from something living [had genetic parents]. The conclusion which must be drawn is that life comes from life. Life must lead back to a Supernatural **Creator** [who is not of this world, uncreated]. Putting faith in a theory disproved long ago is atheism. An agnostic has more than enough information to believe. The Theist has the truth and should remain undaunted.

An intelligent Creator has the power, knowledge and ability to create life. Intelligence is displayed by countless creatures. Animals are amazingly intelligent and sophisticated. None of them has produced the capacity to go to the Moon, Mars or explore space. They can sing, whistle, sit, stand, obey man and many other novel things, but remain

only animals. Animals do not have an inner being like man. Man alone has the great capacity to think, remember, develop and create from other matter unique things. None of man's creations come from "nothing". Something had to be before man could use it in development of any other thing. Matter cannot become a living thing. It is dead [lifeless] and cannot become a living thing. Cloning is nothing more than taking a living cell and processing it until it does what cells do-[i.e. develop into its own kind]. A brain cell will not become a hair, an eye cell cannot become an ear drum and so on is the case. All things are unique.

Matter demands that someone created it. The law of cause and effect stands as an invincible verdict that something cannot come from nothing. What was it that caused or better yet, "who is that cause?" Matter has to be created. Matter is dead and cannot create life. The "big bang theory" fails the test. The questions must be where did the matter come from that exploded? How did a universe develop and not a chaos? The law of thermodynamics precludes that it was an original ball of matter that exploded. Where did the ball come from? What triggered the big bang? Why is there anything at all instead of nothing? If nothing existed than nothing can exist. It is counterintuitive to believe in the origin of matter without an eternal uncreated Creator creating something. No one can successfully argue that the universe is eternal. The second law of thermodynamics teaches that matter and energy become less, not greater over time. The universe cannot be eternal. At one time in the past the material universe did not exist. The universe had a beginning. Since matter is not eternal and could not create itself from nothing the only reasonable answer is God created it. The universe is inexplicable without a supernatural Being. Without eternal power our universe cannot exist

Design demands a Designer. Observation confirms the complexities of our universe. Anything created manifests that there was design requiring intelligence. The universe is finely tuned and functionally complex. Note the sun, moon and stars they are uniquely unified with deliberate design. Plants and animals are a constant reminder of intelligent and deliberated planning. Design is preceded by purposeful planning. Design is an effect, not of unintelligent randomness but rather purposeful thought and consideration as an action of a deliberate designer. Design without purpose is foolishness. The one who built all things was God. Christians do not believe God exists **only** because the Bible says He does. Our faith is in all the promises made and kept, hope which has been fulfilled and evidence of Him in the universe as our Creator and Sustainer.

FAMILY CARE A Message from Our Shepherds

The Belt Line Rd. Church of Christ has faithfully sent financial support to Bro. Oleg Yakimenko for over fifteen years. Oleg and his wife, Natasha, began a congregation of a few members in their rented apartment in St. Petersburg, Russia. Within a few years, they had two boys, Ilya and Timothy. I was blessed to visit them four different times, one time with Dan Flournoy, another time with my wife, Carolyn including Dan and Emily Flournoy, one time with Jerry McKey, and the last time by myself. Personally, I saw this young couple grow in maturity by taking on difficult challenges, not only in their personal lives, but in the church. Oleg had jaw surgery (paid for by Belt Line) and Natasha had some medical problems. They were awakened in bed one night by a burglar standing over them. The congregation grew to about 15 at one point and a split occurred, reducing the congregation to about 7 members. This was one of those events that make some ministers give up in the mission field, but not Oleg. One time, Oleg advertised a meeting at a speaking hall, and someone broke into his apartment during the meeting and stole a laptop that Belt Line had purchased for him. As Oleg's family was growing, so was the congregation. The going was very rough in the beginning, because they were not considered Russian citizens, even though Oleg was born in eastern Russia. They only had "Green Cards" which did not allow them government amenities or free medical. The solution was to be a property owner. Oleg and the congregation began to pray for help in obtaining finances for some property. God does answer prayers. Some years later, an anonymous contributor gave Oleg and his family enough money to buy a new apartment in a nice area by the world renown universities of St. Petersburg Island. This opened the door for Oleg and Natasha to become full-fledged Russian citizens with all the rights to government amenities including free medical. Oleg began to talk to a few Christians from a group who were meeting close to the Neva River. They joined forces and now the Neva Church of Christ has about 75 members. Oleg has travelled to many places in Russia to spread the gospel as well as the Neva congregation. He has now become an important part of the Eastern European Missions (EEM) in Russia as well as remaining the minister of the Neva church. My wife and I have grown to love the Yakimenko family. Belt Line will end the financial support to Oleg in December. Belt Line Rd. should be very proud of the help that we have given Oleg and his family for a job well done and one that we pray will last for many years. Romans 10:14,15

Our Lord Is Our Defender

Biblically a foreigner was a person from a different racial, ethnic, and linguistic group as contrasted with a "native." Circumstances during biblical times often forced people to be expatriates in another country, where they would become "resident aliens" (Genesis 19:9; Ruth 1:1). A less permanent settler was known as a "stranger", "sojourner" or "temporary resident." Sometimes the term "foreigner" had the meaning of "outsider" from a tribe, family or race. The Genesis account records that the first human residents were in a garden, called Eden. After the fall, humanity was exiled and alienated from God. Within this background comes the "promise".

After the flood, there was given a record of the Nations which portrayed the remarkable growth of humanity with a variety of racial and linguistic divisions. The tower of Babel gives the reason for these divisions (Genesis 10; 11:1-9). God confused languages and a dispersion followed. Divided humanity, estranged from God and warring with itself was in desperate need of assurance of a heavenly home. The promise included more than an **earthly place**. Abraham, Sarah and later generations looked for a **better country** (Hebrews 11:13-16).

Early history of the Bible with its curses and collapse of humanity also gave hope. Israel originates, as a nation, with blessings and a divine pledge of land and a promise of Abraham's seed being blessed among alien nations. Abraham obeyed God by emigrating from Ur and becoming an alien (sojourner) in Canaan (Genesis 12:10; 20:1; 23:4). As a patriarch Abraham lived a nomadic life with the only land owned being a grave for Sarah (Genesis 23).

Israel constituted a nation at Sinai (Exodus 19-24). Laws concerning aliens were etched into her legal system. Alien peoples received special protection under the law (Exodus 22:21; 23:9), and were to be loved by native Israelites (Leviticus 19:34). Such protection was necessary as immigrants would not have the social network of kinsmen for support during exigencies. Other ancient Eastern laws and codes stressed protection of widows and orphans. Yet, only Moses' law contained legislation for aliens. After Sinai and the wilderness wanderings, Israel received the gift of a promised land. In order to occupy it however, Israel had to purge the land of its foreign population. Foreigners in this context characterized contamination, hostile agents, who if allowed to remain, would render Israel unholy before God. Paradoxically, only if Israel was pure could she help foreigners (Rahab, Ruth, Naaman, the widow of Zarephath). Psalmists and Prophets conceived of a time when all nations would be subject to a Messianic King ruling with justice. The prophets predicted that all nations would eventually learn of a better way (Isaiah 2:1-4; Micah 4:1-5).

The church is the realization of the hope of a citizenship in heaven. She is a "resident alien" (sojourner and pilgrim) on earth (1 Peter 1:17; 2:11). Christians live in hope and faith, praying and waiting patiently for a new, wonderful home where they will reside with God (Revelation 21-22). Meanwhile, the church acts benevolently helping those in need, remembering all the while that they are but strangers (Matthew 25:35-44). Hospitality (Greek literally, love for the stranger) characterizes disciples of Christ (1 Peter 4:9; Romans 12:13; Hebrews 13:2). Here we are but straying pilgrims. Our path is often dim. "We are often weary but our hearts within us say yonder, beyond our sight, there is a place soon to be our home forever". It brings cheer to our journey. Our Lord is our Defender. Don Hatch
