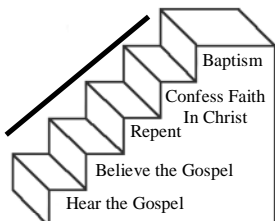

A Message from Our Shepherds

Finally let us discuss how every one of us has influence and the importance of using it for good and not bad. Someone told me that a suspended five hundred pound bar of steel can be made to swing like a pendulum by swinging repeatedly against it a small bottle cork for thirty minutes. Like that little cork, we are all exerting influence. A Christian may be a blot or a blessing; a blank he cannot be. For example: we are born with influence. A little baby changes the whole household, with trips being postponed, meals being rescheduled, and sleeping hours being adjusted. The birth of Moses influenced his parents, his sister, Pharaoh's daughter, and Pharaoh. The birth of Christ influenced His parents, the shepherds, the wise men, the innkeeper and even the king on his throne. We cannot lose our influence. We may lose our good influence, but then we are left with bad influence! Be mindful people do not put our influence in the coffin with us; it lives on and on and on. Please stop to read **Rev. 14:13, Heb. 11:4 and Matt. 26:13b**.

Every step of the way we are consciously or unconsciously exerting an influence upon those with whom we come in contact. Paul said it this way in **Rom. 14:7** "*For none of us lives to himself, and no one dies to himself.*" Yes, we must be careful to ever guard our influence. As a Christian you represent more than yourself. You represent Jesus Christ, Christianity itself, the local congregation, etc. Guard the ideals of all of them well. Our influence is predicated on our reputation, and our reputation upon the kind of lives we live. Therefore, to guard our influence we must guard our lives. Elders, deacons - yes, all Christians - are to be blameless; that is, they are to have a good report (**1 Tim. 3:2, 10**). Never say, "I don't care what others think and say about me." God cares and so should you.

Consequently divine understandings are unfolded and applied. Right understanding of the nature and will of God depends upon using correct methods and understood parts of the Bible to comprehend the more difficult parts. From ancient times the church viewed the Bible in a divine light and honored it. It has been the time honored belief that biblical books were not produced by men who wrote down what they thought, but have always required inspiration from on high guided by the Holy Spirit (2 Pet 1:21, 22).
