



# FAMILY CARE A Message from Our Shepherds

In a thought-provoking article which appeared in Readers Digest a number of years ago, David Raphael Klein noted that the world has been looking for a substitute for God for a long time. He wrote: "Somewhere along the way, Western man began to lose his belief in God as a personal force, as the decider of his fate, as the ultimate judge of his actions. The idea that God created man became old-fashioned; we evolved. The notion of hell was picturesque, but no longer compelling. Life began to be seen as more or less accidental; sin became a relative sociological matter, and too many a pure fiction."

People today are trying all sorts of ineffectual and destructive substitutes for God: Astrology, philosophy, paganism, alcohol, drugs, science, money, pleasure, etc., etc. But whenever people turn away from God, life turns to chaos. Families disintegrate, the social order collapses, and people make a mess of their lives! There is no substitute for God!

- 1. Without God there is no basis for decency and morality. If God is not there, all things are permitted! If Hitler decides to murder 6 million Jews, or terrorists blow up a plane full of women and children, how can we say they are wrong, if God has not spoken? If we no longer believe God created man, then we are forced to say there is nothing sacred about human life. If life is not sacred, then there is no logical argument against murder, rape, assault, or any other crime!
- 2. Without God there is no meaning in life or reason for existence. Man becomes, as one eminent evolutionist expressed it, merely a biological accident created by nature, without purpose, to be obliterated without regret.
- 3. Without God we are left without an explanation for the universe. How can anyone contemplate the eye of a horsefly... the mechanics of human finger movement... the intricacy of the nucleus of a cell... or the complexity of the universe and say all of these things happened by sheer, blind chance?
- 4. Without God we are without hope and are of all men most miserable. David Klein noted, "In freeing himself of the terror of hell, (modern man) gave up the hope of heaven; you live, you die, that's the end of it...."God is the God of all hope (Romans 15:13). Without Him there is no hope in the world (Ephesians 5:12). Belief in God is the only thing that can keep us from despairing about our world and our lives.

**Nothing else can take the place of God.** Nobody else can fill His shoes. For life to have meaning, God must be at the center (Matthew 6:33). There is no substitute for God! Bobby Dockery [from <u>The Voice Of Truth International</u> Volume Twenty-Seven].

Being then the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and device of man. #### 2013 Vacation Bible School

Vacation Bible School (VBS) is a specialized form of religious education which focuses on the children in a community. Congregations usually plan them in the summer in order that children might have a period of study to learn more about Christ. Vacation Bible Schools (VBS) started in the United States around 1894 by a teacher who wanted children to know the Bible. The first VBS was a daily study for four weeks with forty students. A local school was used and an adjacent play ground was used for recess. The aim was to have children in a classroom environment and have specialized lessons for them. Several groups saw the advantage of having children while they were not engaged in public school being taught the principles of the Bible on "graded levels of classes".

Over the years curriculums have been written for VBS. Usually they are designed with a theme to teach a very specific and brief series of lessons where the children learn spiritual and moral principles. This year we will be teaching the life of **Daniel and Christ the Lord**. Each class will be on the level that the child has been in the past school year. Teachers are hard at work gathering materials, handwork and lesson ideas which will engage the children and teaching great Bible principles to direct them along the path of life.

This year's VBS is called "Circus Of Faith" and has five lessons which can be taught. Because we are having a "one day" VBS two of the lessons will be taught. Most of the teachers have chosen to teach Daniel and Jesus Christ. We are using the Lambert VBS material which has great applications for each character. The children will learn about God's grace and love. Each class will be taught on the grade level the students were in last school year.

Enrolment will begin at 8:30 am on Saturday, August 17<sup>th</sup>. Students will go into the Junior Auditorium to sing and at 9:00 am they will be led to their classes. The first period will be until 10:00 am at that time we will have a "cookie break". We hope many will help with this "cookie break". The children always enjoy a beverage and cookies in the middle of the classes. After the break each class will start on their second lesson. At 12:00 noon we will serve "hot dogs and the fixings" in the annex.

**Plan to become a worker and volunteer** for one or more of the parts of this *VBS*. We will pass out door hangers August 3<sup>rd</sup>. Please meet in annex at 8:00 am to prepare materials and go out. Needed are workers and drivers for the teenager. There are labels for door hangers and posters to be taken to stores, plus *much much* more. God bless our effort in His name! Plan to be in annex at 8:00 Am Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup>. **Don Hatch**
