The Things I Cannot Have

No one likes to be told "no". If we want something, we want it. Life tells us there are things I cannot have. Paul wrote, "...I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content." (Phil. 4:11) The Bible does talk about the need for us to have character (Rom. 5:3-4), and nothing builds character more than working for the things that we want (Matt. 10:10; 1 Tim. 5:18) realizing that there are some things beyond our reach.

In Christianity, regardless of who I am, God has made easily available and accessible the things in life we can all have or achieve. (2 Pet. 1:3) Paul told Timothy, "...pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness." (1 Tim. 6:11) The Hebrew writer exhorted Christians to "Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord." (Heb. 12:14) These are all things that are easily accomplished by dedication to serving God and seeking His righteousness. (Matt. 6:33)

Unfortunately, there are things that some Christians set their sights on that the Bible says they cannot have. This greatly affects the Lord's church. In 1 Tim. 3:1, Paul tells Timothy that men who would be selected to oversee the Lord's church must "desire" the office. There are many Christians who stop reading right there and conclude that simply because a man has the "desire" to be an Elder they are qualified. Nothing could be further from the truth. While it is true that a man must desire the office, if he is not biblically qualified, he cannot and must not be selected to serve as an Elder. (1 Tim. 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-9; 1 Pet. 5:1-4) One of the great problems in the Lord's church today is men who are serving as Elders whose only qualification is that they wanted to be an Elder! Congregations, Christians, families, and communities continue to be destroyed by unscriptural Elderships. No matter how much I might want to be an Elder, if I am not qualified I cannot serve and congregations must not put me in that position.

Another current area of concern in the church is the desire of Christian women to be placed in positions of leadership. Since 1 Tim. 3 and Titus 1 specifically state that an Elder is to be the "husband of one wife," women are excluded from serving as Elders. They may have the desire but they can never be qualified in the sight of God. The qualifications for Deacons in 1 Tim. 3 have the same restriction of the "husband of one wife" (vs. 12) and include "qualifications" for the Christian woman as a wife of the deacon. (vs. 11) Women are likewise forbidden scripturally from taking any leadership role in the worship assembly. (1 Tim. 2:12) No published position paper, proclamation, edict or "ruling" by man can change God's word. The desire to lead may be there. The talent to lead may be there. But God has spoken. This ends the discussion.

Let us be content with pursuing godliness and heaven through obedience instead of what we want outside of God's word.
