

METONYMY (Part 4) (mi-ton-uh-mee)

We previously noted the figure of speech often used whereby the "**cause**" of the matter is put for its "**effect**." This is referred to as *Metonymy of the Cause*. This figure of speech is often used in reference to the Holy Spirit.

The apostle Paul writes: "Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God, who also made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life" (2 Cor. 3:6).ⁱ

The "we" here is Paul, Sylvanus, and Timothy (see 2 Cor.1:19-24, and note all the pronouns making distinction between them). Paul says God made them ("us") sufficient minsters of the new covenant. They were not ministers of the letter (the law of Moses) but of Spirit, which is the very thing to which he just referred – the new covenant. He then says the letter kills but the Spirit gives life.

The point is this. They were ministers of the new covenant, not the law of Moses (the letter). They were ministers of the "**Spirit**," which is used in place of the previously mentioned **new covenant**. Why? Because **the letter kills** (the law of Moses) **but the Spirit** (new covenant) gives life. Note the connection with what Jesus taught in John 6:63: "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life."

Jesus said **the Spirit gives life**. But how? Through the words by which Jesus spoke for **they are spirit and they are life**. Here we see an association – a connection – between the Spirit giving life and the words of Christ giving life. This is why Paul commands us to "**take the helmet of salvation**, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God" (Eph. 6:17). The Spirit keeps on giving life **through His sword** – **the word of God**. If we are not living by the word of God, there is no life in us because we are not imbibing the life-giving words of the Spirit. This means the Spirit is not dwelling in us because His life-giving words are not dwelling in our hearts (Col. 3:16; Ephesians 5:18; 1 John 3:24).

In 2 Cor.3:6, Paul uses the word "**Spirit**" (the cause) in association with, and in place of the **new covenant** (the effect that saves) because He is the source of the new covenant. However, the Spirit gives life through the new covenant. Therefore Paul, Sylvanus, and Timothy were ministers of the life-giving new covenant message, of which the Spirit is the source. The law of Moses kills because it was no longer efficacious, being nailed to the cross. Trying to live by it brings death (Gal. 5:1-4).

Another example of the use of *Metonymy of the Cause* is found in the parallel passages of Matthew 7:11 and Luke 11:13, which we will address next time.

ⁱ In both times the word "Spirit" is found 2 Cor. 3:6, it is without the definite article ("the"). The Greek manuscripts do not include the definite article. We will discuss the nature of the definite article another time.
