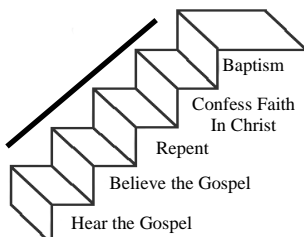

I was invited to College Hill Church of Christ last week to give them an updated Mission Printing presentation. Mission Printing appreciates their efforts for the past 25 years or so. Their elders have financially supported us every month as long as I can remember. At one time, several volunteers came every Tuesday to help us collate large books like the children’s “Jesus Loves Me” series and the 100 page Songbooks that we print. Some of their volunteers operated the staplers, trimming machines and the printing presses. I hope my visit will encourage their volunteers to return and help us with the large books that we print.

I am proud to say almost the same thing about our congregation at Belt Line Rd. Our elders have always been financially supporting the monthly costs of Mission Printing. Robert Taylor is usually there 2 times a week. Every Tuesday, he is there to operate the large press, printing over a million pages a day. During the week he usually transports material, back and forth from Glen Kelly’s house as Glen collates and staples about 5,000 tracts a week. This week Donna Davis will start collating/stapling boxes of tracts to add to Robert’s transportation trip. Darrel Allen is usually there for every container shipment, giving that extra muscle, to make it a successful loading of 37,000 pounds of “World Evangelism by the Printed Page”, in less than 2 hours. We have received a \$50,000 donation as a challenge to ship 5 ocean containers of material in 2022. We are on schedule and hope to ship the second container this month. Many of you help support Mission Printing through your memorial and honor donations for your loved ones and friends. I challenge you to organize a carload of Belt Line volunteers to come one day a month to Mission Printing to collate the big books that we need for the children and songbooks for the churches. I have been blessed with over 20 years of retirement and the majority of my time has been at Mission Printing, enjoying the work of serving others the word of God. Remember the song, “I Want to be a Worker for the Lord.”
