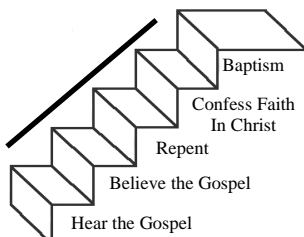

THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Hear - Romans 10:17
Believe - John 8:24
Repent - Acts 17:30

When Paul stood witnessing before the Areopagus he stated;

“²⁶ And He has made from one ^[a]blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined their pre-appointed times and the boundaries of their dwellings, ²⁷ so that they should seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us; ²⁸ for in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, ‘For we are also His offspring.

(Acts 17:26-28)

I wonder when he stated “for in Him we live and move and have our being” did he picture in his mind a similar, physical manifestation of that sentiment his ancestors knew, The Pillar of Cloud and Fire. The very same supernatural phenomena God sent to guide, protect and illuminate the children of Israel during their stay in the desert.

¹⁵ Now on the day that the tabernacle was raised up, the cloud covered the tabernacle, the tent of the Testimony; from evening until morning it was above the tabernacle like the appearance of fire. ¹⁶ So it was always: the cloud covered it by day, and the appearance of fire by night.

(Numbers 9:15,16)

²² Whether it was two days, a month, or a year that the cloud remained above the tabernacle, the children of Israel would remain encamped and not journey; but when it was taken up, they would journey. ²³ At the command of the LORD they remained encamped, and at the command of the LORD they journeyed; they kept the charge of the LORD, at the command of the LORD by the hand of Moses. (Numbers 9 22-23)

With the manna in the morning, the quail in the evening (Ex. 16:8), their clothes not wearing out (Deut. 29:5) and marching/camping only at his command, the ancient Israelites literally/physically lived, moved and existed by the hand of God. It is easy to sit back, shake our heads in disbelief and judge their faithfulness. One could say they bit the hand that fed them and one would be right. One would also be right to say that we today are also, daily provided for by God, having the benefit of the ancient ones’ good and bad examples plus the realization of what was only a promised to them, Christ Jesus the Messiah. the one who nailed to the cross the Old Law and it’s cumbersome requirements. (Col. 2:14) How truly blessed we are to be living in these times, troubled as they may be.

So today and every day, let’s strive to walk in the light (1 John 1:7) along the difficult way that leads to the narrow gate (Matt. 7:14), seeking the kingdom of God and its righteousness (Mt. 6:33) while being lights ourselves amongst a crooked and perverse generation (Phil. 2:15).
