

# BAPTIZED IN THE HOLY SPIRIT (PART 10 D) Doug Post

*"If the Spirit were the element specifically being referenced, then we have the difficulty of explaining how we are baptized in the Spirit and then that we come out of the Spirit. If we were to come out of the Spirit, we would lose the benefit or the effect of that element.*<sup>1</sup>

Last week we noted how the above quote implies several things. First, it implies a person never arises from being baptized in the Spirit, which is admitted in the above quote. Our brother is attempting to make the point that a person is **literally** baptized INTO the Holy Spirit and **literally** remains within Him (and the Spirit, at the same time, of course, is now **literally** inside the person), poses a real problem our brother's doctrine. How can the Holy Spirit, who is completely pure – not having any sin, or any inclination to sin – having no darkness within Himself, have a sinful person **literally** residing inside Him?

Remember, our brother is arguing that a person is **literally** baptized in the Holy Spirit, being **literally**, and spatially, inside the perfect, sinless, pure Holy Spirit, even though the Holy Spirit tells us that "**God is light and in Him is no darkness at all**" (1 John 1:5), so how can a sinful person **literally** be inside Deity? How can a person who will continue to sin, **literally** be inside Deity? Does the Holy Spirit kick the person (who is **literally** inside Him), out of his Spirit body, and does the Holy Spirit (who is said to **literally** be inside the person who sins), jump out of the person every time he sins? Quite simply, absurdity begets absurdity.

We also noted that our brother teaches the Holy Spirit, allegedly, must change the "nature" of the human spirit even though the person is baptized for the forgiveness of sins and saved (Acts 2:38, 22:16; cf. Mark 16:16). That the Holy Spirit **literally** touches the human spirit, cleansing and removing all remaining impurities that baptism in water missed, "regenerating" the person. It is here that, allegedly, the Holy Spirit supernaturally infuses spiritual steroids into the person, causing the person to come alive, spiritually. And within this process the Holy Spirit **literally** submerges the person into Himself, from which the person never arises. But the Holy Spirit teaches that baptism involves (1) being buried in water and (2) arising from the same element (water), which is in the likeness of Christ's death, burial, and resurrection (Rom.6:3-6). But our brother eliminates the concept of "arising," redefining baptism to sustain his view. In fact, our brother tells us that being baptized in the Holy Spirit is just like being baptized in water:

"Now if the birth that involves water is a baptism in water, then why shouldn't we think that the birth that involves the Spirit would also be a baptism in Spirit? If water is an element, then why wouldn't Spirit as used in the same reference be an element as well? It is not sufficient to explain John 3:3-5 by claiming that all that is involved is baptism in water in harmony with the word of the Spirit"<sup>2</sup>

Our brother teaches that baptism in water is to be viewed as being identical with baptism in the Holy Spirit but argues for something different when he eliminates the concept of "arising" from the Spirit. If one comes out of the element of water, then one would expect one would come out of the Holy Spirit if both were identical. Our brother is not making a case for baptism, he's making a case for drowning, as he as the person literally and perpetually immersed inside the Spirit, which implies the person cannot sin. How can sin exist if a person is literally inside Deity? After all, there is no darkness at all in the Holy Spirit. Yes, absurdity begets absurdity. However, the concept of a figurative dwelling of Deity has no such difficulties because it does not teach such absurdity as the Spirit having to jump in and out of a person due to his sin. We will pick up here next week.
