

BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT (PART 10 A) Doug Post

We previously noted how some are redefining the word "baptized" and equating the concept of "*baptized in the Holy Spirit*" (Acts 1:4-5) with the concept of baptized "*out from water and out from Spirit*" (John 3:5). Sadly, the error multiplies as seen in the following:

"But before a man can be given the indwelling of the Spirit, he must be regenerated by the Spirit so that his nature is changed. And this is clearly when a man is baptized in water. As a man's body is lowered in the water, the Holy Spirit submerges the man's spirit within himself to change his nature. And at the very precise moment when God considers that man no longer sinner but now saint, at that precise instant, the regenerating submerging Spirit moves from the outside to the inside of the heart (Tit.3:5; Gal.4:6). Less than this we cannot write, more than this we do not know."¹

The above reflects, at best, a superficial understanding of the matter. First, there is no such Greek term as "the indwelling." Such a man-made term is intended to show a particular bias in evincing some special dwelling of one member of the Godhead, while the other two members of the Godhead (who also dwell), seemingly maintain an inferior dwelling. However, when such things are repeated long enough, without correction, folks believe it.

Second, where is a "**Thus saith the Lord**" for the assertions made in the above? Words are written but Scriptural evidence is severely lacking. Where is the passage, or passages, teaching what is being advocated? I'm sure if they existed, they would have been readily provided, but that is not the case here. The truth is, there is no passage of Scripture which teaches the above chronological process or systematic order. Quite simply, personal commentary has been provided but no Scripture.

Third, the Holy Spirit, Himself, teaches that Jesus is the only administrator of baptism in the Holy Spirit (Matt.3:11). Therefore, where is the passage declaring the Holy Spirit baptizes people into Himself? What passage teaches the Holy Spirit moves into the person being baptized in water? Remember, regeneration is being born again, but John 3:5 specifically teaches that one is born *out from water and out from Spirit*.

Lastly, Titus 3:5 was cited regarding the idea of the Spirit moving "from the outside to the inside of the heart," but where does that passage even mention said transition? Such is not even contemplated in the text itself. Galatians 4:6 was then cited, as if it was referring to the Holy Spirit. Is Paul referring to the Holy Spirit here? Paul writes: "And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, Abba, Father!" The Galatians became "sons" (children) and then received the Spirit. How could they be sons prior to and without the Spirit? After all, Romans 8:9 teaches that folks not having the Spirit cannot belong to God, right? The phrase the spirit of His Son (spirit of His child) is simply the attitude or mindset of His Son. The spirit of His Son does not mean the Holy Spirit of Jesus.

Paul said the Galatians were "sons" (children) already before God sent them the Spirit **into their hearts**, with which the brother agrees. However, according to his quote, one is washed then regenerated and that's just the way it is. Considering this information, how could the Galatians be children of God before they were regenerated (baptized in the Spirit, especially since Romans 8:9 teaches that anyone not having the Spirit (regenerated) cannot belong to God? Herein lies a major contradiction. Brethren, when one's teachings are measured by God's Word and inconsistencies and contradictions appear, then one's dogmatic doctrine is wrong. This is an important point which we will pick up next week.
