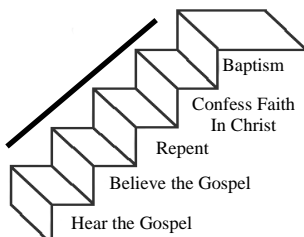

THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Hear - Romans 10:17
 Believe - John 8:24
 Repent - Acts 17:30
 Confess - Romans 10:10
 Be Baptized - Acts 22:16

Below are eleven occasions recorded in the Gospel of John where Jesus clearly states his purpose. To do the will of and please God His Father.

1. Jesus said to them, “My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work. Jn. 4:34

2. I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will but the will of the Father who sent Me. Jn. 5:30

3. For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. Jn. 6:38

4. Jesus answered them and said, “My doctrine is not Mine, but His who sent Me. Jn. 7:16

5. And He who sent Me is with Me. The Father has not left Me alone, for I always do those things that please Him.” Jn. 8:29

6. I and My Father are one. Jn.10:30

7. For I have not spoken on My own authority; but the Father who sent Me gave Me a command, what I should say and what I should speak. Jn 12:49

8. Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. Jn 14:10

9. He who does not love Me does not keep My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine but the Father’s who sent Me. Jn 14:24

10. If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father’s commandments and abide in His love. Jn.15:10

11. Now they have known that all things which You have given Me are from You. For I have given to them the words which You have given Me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came forth from You; and they have believed that You sent Me. Jn. 17:7-8

Now if we have been crucified in Christ and He lives in us (Gal. 2:20), does our life mimic his? Is knowing and completing the will of the Father, our food, our purpose, our reason for being? Are we striving to make God’s will our own. Has our stubborn will at last yielded? Have we surrendered all? Are we walking daily by and not from the Savior’s side? With yes being the desired answer let us make it so. Have a wonderful week in the Lord.
