

This is a continuation from last week talking about "The Sower" found in **Matthew 13:1-23** and today we are going to identify the four different soils (hearts).

The first soil is the wayside soil. This one is about one who heard the word, but the wicked one took it away quickly. "When anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received seed by the wayside" Matt. 13:19. Here the word has been placed in the heart, but the person does not understand it, nor does he care to understand it. Before the word can work on this person, the devil comes along and snatches it out of his heart least it has time to germinate and grow. Luke adds, "...then the devil comes and takes away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be saved" Luke 8:12. Satan does not want the word of God to remain in a person's heart very ling because he knows if it does, it will begin to work in that person.

The second soil is stony soil, "But he who received the seed on stony places, this is he who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; ²¹ yet he has no root in himself, but endures only for a while. For when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles" Matthew 13:20-21. The stony place is a heart that has no place where the seed can take root. It just lays on the top and can never penetrate the enter part of the heart. The Lord says it endures only for a while, but over time tribulations and persecution will come because of the word being preached, and they will be offended because the word is not rooted deeply into their heart, and soon they will fall away. We have all seen those who are excited about obeying the gospel, and at first, they have great zeal, but soon life sets in, and they begin to understand that the word of God teaches them that they must give up some things to be truly converted to the Lord. The word will often offend them, and they will slowly drift back into the world.

We will continue our other types of soil next week.
