

THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Earnestly Contend for the Faith

Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints (Jude 3).

After Jude had directed his thoughts away from writing a gospel account, the intensity of the growing battle for "the faith" came into focus. Perhaps Jude was aware of Paul's observation that we do not "wrestle" against ordinary forces, but our battle deals with the "spiritual wickedness in high places" (Ephesians 6:12).

The special word chosen by the Holy Spirit to speak to this struggle in Jude's letter was *epagonizomai*. We find this word being used by the apostle Paul elsewhere, he writes: "I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith" (2 Timothy 4:7). Paul also notes what "great conflict" he felt for the church at Colosse (Colossians 2:1) and that Epaphras was "always laboring fervently" for them in his prayers (Colossians 4:12).

The object of this spiritual struggle was "the faith which was once delivered unto the saints." Two matters are of importance in that little phrase. First, "the faith" is a specific designation used in the New Testament to incorporate the doctrines or teachings of the New Covenant. The designation, "the faith," is used synonymously with such words as, the gospel, the word, the New Testament or Covenant, etc.

Quite simply, "the faith" is the "objective standard of truth" (the gospel) revealed to mankind by inspired men (Gal.1:23, 1 Tim.5:8; Acts 6:7; Col.1:23, Jude 3). The early churches were "established in the faith" (Acts 16:5). We are to "stand fast in the faith" (1 Corinthians 16:13). Again, the apostle writes: "Examine your own selves, whether you are in the faith; prove your own selves" (2 Cor. 13:5). We are to constantly compare our lives by the standard of truth we call the Bible.

Second, that body of doctrine referred to as "the faith" was "once delivered to the saints." Implicit in that comment is that the Holy Spirit both guided and spoke through the apostles the responsibility of the Holy Spirit to "guide [the apostles] into all truth" (John 16:13). Both Old and New Testaments insist that we are not to add to or subtract from the words of God's Word. Jude's epistle emphasizes the awful judgment that comes upon those who would distort or disdain what is "the faith."

The Greek term "hapax" means "once for all time," such as when Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many (Heb. 9:28; cf. 1 Pet. 3:18). Jude affirms the finality of revelation. There would not be any need for continuing revelation. God providing mankind with His final Will (the faith) — also referred to as the Scriptures. God's system of truth was fully and finally made known within the completed New Testament record. There is no continuing revelation, with accompanying spiritual gifts, today (cf. 1 Cor. 13:8-10; Eph. 4:11-16) as some are to claim.
