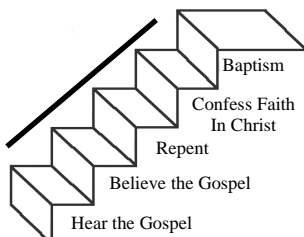

For ten years or so now, I have coached girls rec softball. If I were to pick an all-star team from the 100 or so girls I have coached, based on one thing, that one thing would be their attitude. (“A feeling or way of thinking that affects a person's behavior”) Being fast, slow, big, small, more or less athletic would mean little or nothing to me. The “dirty dozen” that would make the team would each, in their own way, be ecstatic to be on the field and ready and willing to chew through a chain link fence to get the job done. The verses below remind me of those girls and why I would choose them.

“Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things.” Phil. 4: 8 (positive, hopeful and a joy to be around.)

“And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ”. Col. 3:23-24 (Putting their heart into their efforts)

“His lord said to him, ‘Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.’ Mt 25:21

(Parable of the talents. They worked hard with what God gave them, grew and produced.)

“Therefore, whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock.” Mt 7:24 (Coachable, determined and dedicated)

I am grateful to God for all the players I have had the privilege to coach, especially those that resemble the above verses. Whether they knew it or not, by their example, they inspired and elevated others and exemplified what the game was about. (Phil 2:15) Their efforts were not always successful.
