

# **Except You Abide in the Ship You Cannot Be Saved Doug Post**

The year is A.D. 61. The Apostle Paul is in route to the great Roman capital to be tried before the throne of Caesar. He is traveling through the Mediterranean Sea during one of the most dangerous times of the year for sea travel. The powerful *Euroclydon wind*, infamous for the havoc it wreaks upon ships and human life, has sprung into full force. Various attempts to make progress with its cargo by utilizing alternate routes and periodic safe harbors have been employed.

Paul warned against leaving the safety of Crete, but the ship's masters have not heeded his advice. Instead, they have again put to sea and rounded Crete heading into the treacherous waters near Malta. The ship, its crew, and its passengers, including Paul, are all imperiled. But an angel of God assures Paul that no loss of life will occur, and the only loss will be of the ship (Acts 27:13-22).

Paul informs the ship's complement he believes God and that all will be according to what He has said through the angel. There is often a marked difference between believing in God and genuinely believing God. Many profess the former, but few practice the latter. It is not enough to believe there is one God. Even the devils believe that and tremble from their knowledge. Yet they are not saved (James 2:18-26; Hebrews 5:8-9).

Believing God to the saving of our souls involves putting full confidence in God's Word that everything will be "even as He has said" (Acts 27:23-25). At the most critical time in the ship's last hours Paul advises the centurion and the soldiers guarding him that, "Unless these men abide in the ship, you cannot be saved" (Acts 27:31). The ship would eventually break apart but not before providing the means needed to get all souls aboard safely into waters where its flotsam and jetsam could be used to arrive on the shore of Malta (vs. 32-44).

What a lesson for us! "Except they abide in the ship, you cannot be saved." The church of our Lord is the ark of safety – the great ship of Zion. The saved are in it (Acts 2:47; Ephesians 5:23). The object lesson is a reminder for God's people to abide safely in the church – in its work, worship, and service – in order to land safely on the shore of eternity in that land that is fairer than day. When the storms of life come, we also need the encouragement and strength of faithful brethren to help us through difficult times. As it has been said, "no man is an island unto himself," which the Bible taught long before the poet, Donne, was born.

Let us then be "steadfast, unmovable, and always abounding in the work of the Lord..." (1 Corinthians 15:58). Paul demonstrated this so beautifully in life, both on land and in the midst of his trials at sea, because he believed God that "it will be even as He has said."
