

THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Hear - Romans 10:17 Believe - John 8:24 Repent - Acts 17:30 Confess - Romans 10:10 Be Baptized - Acts 22:16 Saved - in Christ (Galatians 3:27)



BAPTIZED IN THE HOLY SPIRIT (PART 6) Doug Post

John the baptizer prepared the Jews for the coming the Messiah (Isa. 40:1-11; Mal.3:1, 4:5-6; Matt.3:3). He told them to repent and be baptized in water for the forgiveness of sins (Mark 1:4). Out of curiosity, the Pharisees and Sadducees went out to the Jordan where John was baptizing (Matt.3:7-12. Knowing their ungodly character, John spoke publicly about judgment and punishment saying, "He will baptize you in the Holy Spirit and fire" (Matt.3:11).

John's mission was to the Jews. His preaching and promises were for the Jews (Matt.3:1-11; Isa.40:1-3), which included the Pharisees and Sadducees. The promise of being baptized in the Holy Spirit was never made to the Gentiles. Out from among the Jews Jesus called twelve men to be His apostles (Matt.10). He then took John's general promise of baptism in the Spirit and applied it to His apostles (Luke 24:47-49; John 14,15, 16; Acts 1:1-8, 2:1-4). The Spirit would overwhelm the apostles with supernatural aid, guidance, and power, in order to carry out the special assignment Jesus gave them (Luke 24:47-49; Acts 1:8).

If the promise of being baptized in the Holy Spirit was made only to the Jews, and if only the Jewish apostles were baptized in the Holy Spirit, what do we make of Cornelius and his household (Acts 10:1, 11:18)? Was not Cornelius baptized in the Holy Spirit? Some brethren believe so based solely on Acts 11:16-17: "Then I remembered the word of the Lord, how He said, 'John indeed baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit.' ¹⁷ If therefore God gave them the same gift as He gave us when we believed on the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could withstand God?" To properly understand any biblical matter, we must gather and consider all that is said: "The sum of thy word is truth (Psalm 119:160). We must never set aside context by relying on only one verse.

Only the apostles were promised to be baptized in the Holy Spirit. Cornelius was never promised such, and neither was he supplied the same overwhelming, supernatural power from the Spirit as the apostles. Please keep in mind the meaning of "baptized." Rather, Cornelius received the "like gift" – the gift of speaking in tongues, to which Luke referred as the Holy Spirit's gift or gift of the Holy Spirit. The Gentiles had no part in John's baptism nor in the general promise of being baptized in the Spirit.

In part 5 we demonstrated that Acts 11:16-17 discussed **manner**, not **measure**. Both the apostles' and Cornelius received power from on high – directly from Deity, not from the laying on of hands. The manifestation of the Spirit (*speaking in tongues*) that occurred on Pentecost (Acts 2:1-8) was the very same manifestation that occurred with Cornelius (Acts 10:45-46, 11:17). Moreover, the expressions "**fell upon**" and "**poured out**" do not equate with "**baptized**." Those who claim that Cornelius was baptized in the Holy Spirit, and who received the exact same baptism as the apostles, must redefine "**baptized**."

Being baptized in the Spirit, the apostles received direct communication from Deity, telling them what to do and speak. If Cornelius received the same baptism, why would the Spirit not directly communicate with Cornelius what he needed to do? Why would the Holy Spirit-inspired Peter have to tell the Holy Spirit-inspired Cornelius what to do, if Cornelius had the same baptism?

Because Cornelius did not receive baptism in the Holy Spirit. Rather, he received the "**like**" gift – *speaking in tongues* – that was **poured out** and **fell** on him (Acts 10:44-45), referred to as **the Holy Spirit's gift**. There is nothing in the context saying Cornelius was baptized in the Holy Spirit. One must not read into the verse what is not there.

I do not cease to pray for the progress and sustainability of Mission Printing. Through your efforts, the Church is moving to enviable height, converting souls, keeping the saved. We also use some during Sunday morning Bible study.
