

DEFEATING SATAN WITH THE TRUTH Doug Post

There are times when we simply can't focus, or not "thinking straight." Maybe it's because we are overthinking something because we have many ideas coming at us from all directions, making it difficult to sift through them all. However, when it comes to spiritual matters, we need to make the effort to discern good from evil. The Hebrews writer says:

For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil (Hebrews 5:13-14).

Even though we know the devil works by deceiving us, we still allow ourselves to be fooled by his trickery and cunning craftiness (2 Cor.11:3), and by his wicked schemes we are taken captive. The apostle Paul writes:

And a servant of the Lord must not quarrel but be gentle to all, able to teach, patient, in humility correcting those who are in opposition, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth, and that they may come to their senses and escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will (2 Timothy 2:24-26).

Of course, this does not have to happen because God's Truth – His word – is always available. And in the strength, might, and power of His Truth, we can overcome all evil and every temptation standing between us and God. We simply do not have to be deceived and be taken captive by the devil.

True faith "diligently" seeks for God through His Truth (Heb.11:6). So, the question is, do we truly desire to know the truth, and do it? Some were trying to understand if Jesus' teachings figure were true, so Jesus said: "If anyone wills to do His will, he shall know concerning the doctrine, whether it is from God or whether I speak on My own authority" (John 7:17). Those who truly desire not only to know God's truth but also to obey it will be able to discern the difference between truth and error. But if we do not care to know His Truth and obey it, then we will never recognize Truth when we see it.

The devil hates us. His intent is to spiritually kill us, robbing us from eternal life. He is no friend. Paul warns us not to be deceived and lose our salvation: "See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ" (Col. 2:8).

The power of God's Truth – His word – is inescapable. As the devil does his work by deception, God does His by Truth. Jesus said, "You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free" (Jn. 8:32). However, are you determined and willing to search for Truth and hold on to it? Therefore, let us, "Buy the truth, and sell it not" (Prov. 23:23).
