

## THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Hear - Romans 10:17 Believe - John 8:24 Repent - Acts 17:30 Confess - Romans 10:10 Be Baptized - Acts 22:16 Saved - in Christ (Galatians 3:27)



### THE KINGDOM - CHURCH (PART 3)

The significance of the kingdom – the church (Matt.16:18-19) – cannot be overstated. Jesus purchased the church with His blood (Acts 20:28), making Him the Savior of the body or church (Ephesians 5:23). Therefore, while Jesus died for all people, all people will be saved. Salvation is granted when sins are forgiven, and sins are forgiven upon obedience to the Lord's will (Matt.7:21; Luke 6:46; Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38, 22:16; 1 Pet.3:21, 4:17; cf. 2 Thess.2:7-9). When one is baptized **FOR** the forgiveness of sins (Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38, 22:16; 1 Pet.3:21; cf. John 3:3-5), the Lord adds them to His kingdom/church (Acts 2:41, 47, Col.1:13).

Forgiveness is extended to the obedient, only, because He is the "author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him" (Heb.5:9). Christ shed His blood for ALL, but He applies His blood only to those who obey (continue obeying) Him. Immersion in water for the forgiveness of sins (Acts 22:16) is an act of faith, which activates the cleansing blood of Christ (Rev.1:5). Baptism and His blood are connected (Rom.6:3-6; Gal.3:26-27; Col.2:12-13, 3:1-2), because baptism, as the very means by which the cleaning blood is activated in the person's life. Therefore, baptism is necessary for the forgiveness of sins. It is at this point one becomes a member of the Lord's kingdom/church.

The Parable of the Sower demonstrates one is saved by grace through faith, by means of "the word of the kingdom" (Matt.13:19). This word, the gospel, the faith, the truth, the doctrine, and the new covenant – all the same body of doctrine – is the seed. The Spirit gives life, but He does through a means, which Jesus identifies: "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life" (John 6:63). Jesus explains that the Spirit gives life through the very words Jesus spoke, and those words are God's power to save souls who obey (Rom.1:16-17; 1 Pet.1:22-23; James 1:18, 21).

So, we have said all of that to say this: since the saved are in the Lord's kingdom/church, how can we determine which teaching from **the word of the kingdom** are we to apply the n the kingdom/church to follow. In other words, how do we determine what doctrine or teaching is essential for salvation? The prophet Isaiah speaks of the coming Messiah and His coming kingdom (Isa.2:2-4, 9:7: cf. Dan.12:44). In Isaiah 66:22-23 the prophet speaks of the coming of a new system of things (new heavens and new earth is a figure), wherein God's people would routinely come together to worship Him. In fact, "**all flesh**," both Jew and Gentile, would worship Him.

The Lord's kingdom (Isa.9:7) is the Lord's house (2:2-3), and the Lord's house is the church (1 Tim.3:15). We can read of first century Christians assembling for worship (Acts 20:7; 1 Cor.16:1-2; Heb.10:24-25), which included the Lord's Supper, prayer, singing, giving, and preaching. Isaiah's prophecy of the coming Messiah has been fulfilled, as well as the coming kingdom. Therefore, it is rather obvious that worship, as part of the kingdom/church has also been fulfilled. We will return to discuss how we can apply **the word of the kingdom** to our lives, determining what is authoritative, or obligatory, to the 21<sup>st</sup> kingdom/church.
