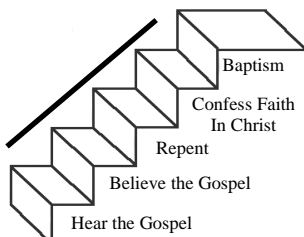

Happy New Year, my beloved. Hope you did enjoy it over there in a very big way. I am so glad that we made it to 2022 with good health and God's blessings. Thank you for your prayers.

2021 Monthly Analysis

January: 1 released, 4 restorations. (Released Christian prisoners are assisted in finding local congregations in their area of residence.)

February: 4 Baptisms at Central prison. (Vincent works different prisons.)

March: 11 Baptisms at Bolo congregation. (He is also active with different congregations.)

April: 4 Baptisms and 1 released from Central prison and 1 baptism at the Mongo lectureship. (Vincent is active in the brotherhood.)

May: 6 Baptisms at Central prison. Bomaka brethren helped the inmates with half bags of rice and garri. (Vincent encourages the brethren to assist the inmates)

June: 1 released from Central prison. 8 Baptisms at Kombe congregation and 4 restorations.

July: 3 released and 6 Baptisms at Central prison. (Vincent usually takes the released Christians to a local congregation and introduces them.)

August: 1 released and 7 Baptisms at Central prison.

September and October reports, I can't find them in my phone. I don't know why, maybe I accidentally deleted them.

November: 7 Baptisms and 1 released from Central prison. Annual 4 Baptism. 20 Bibles from Mission Printing USA to Buea Central prison.

December: 5 Baptisms and 2 released from Central prison.
