

THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Hear - Romans 10:17 Believe - John 8:24 Repent - Acts 17:30 Confess - Romans 10:10 Be Baptized - Acts 22:16 Saved - in Christ (Galatians 3:27)



Calvinism (Part Five) Total Hereditary Depravity Doug Post

Calvinism declares sin to be inherited. That the sin of Adam corrupted humanity, and we inherited the guilt and effects of this sin by "natural generation." Therefore, all babies are born little, sinful devils because of the actions of others (Adam & Eve). This is referred to as *Total Hereditary Depravity*.

And because we have inherited this *corrupt nature*, we only will to do evil. Therefore, Calvinism teaches we are all guilty of sin based upon genetics, even though the Bible teaches sin is a result of breaking God's laws (1 John 3:4). It teaches humanity is sinful because of the sin of Adam, even though the Bible teaches that the "soul who sins shall die. The son shall not bear the guilt of the father, not shall the father bear the guilt of the son. The righteousness of the righteous shall be on himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself" (Ezek.18:20). Calvinism teaches that sin is not an individual choice, but something one is born with, even though the Bible teaches that, "each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his OWN desires and enticed" (James 1:14).

Total Hereditary Depravity asserts that because of our alleged human depravity, we cannot respond to the gospel of Christ, unless and until there is a direct work (influence) of the Holy Spirit on our mind. What does that mean? God is said to send the Holy Spirit to directly regenerate some (not all) who are totally depraved and unable to do right. It is argued that the Holy Spirit must supernaturally, manipulate the depraved human mind so that the person can understand and respond to the gospel. That without such a direct, supernatural intervention and manipulation, the individual will never believe (have faith) and respond to the gospel, even though the Bible teaches that "faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God" (Rom.10:17).

The idea that the Holy Spirit must directly manipulate the human mind/heart so the person can understand and believe the gospel, is completely foreign to Scripture. Such a doctrine eliminates human free will: "How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach unless they are sent? (Romans 10:14-15). It minimizes God's power to salvation – the gospel: "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation" (Romans 1:16; cf. James 1:18,21; 1 Peter 1:22-23). Paul further declares: "Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain" (1 Cor.15:1-2). To the Ephesians Paul writes: "In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise" (Eph.1:13). Much more can be said but this will suffice for our purposes.

Finally, Calvinism says we inherit our corrupt nature of Adam, so why is not the reverse true? To this question our attention will turn in next week's article.
