

THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Hear - Romans 10:17 Believe - John 8:24 Repent - Acts 17:30 Confess - Romans 10:10 Be Baptized - Acts 22:16 Saved - in Christ (Galatians 3:27)



BAPTIZED IN THE HOLY SPIRIT (PART 9) Doug Post

Some are teaching modern day *baptism in the Holy Spirit*, alleging that it is an ongoing, normative, phenomenon. John 3:5 is one passage used to prove their case.¹ However, the sad truth of the matter is that such a faulty conclusion is the result of perverting the Scriptures (1 Peter 3:16). Let's consider what our Lord said on the matter.

Jesus said the following to Nicodemus: "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God" (John 3:5). This helps explain the process of being "born again" (John 3:3).² Jesus plainly states that this process is not an optional matter, if one is going to be saved: "Do not marvel that I said to you, "'You must be born again'" (John 3:7).

When one is born again, he or she is **born out from water** and **out from Spirit**. The Greek preposition **ek** (or **ex**) means "**out from**." The phrase, "**born out from**," is used elliptically, modifying both "water" and "Spirit." Therefore, Jesus literally said: "**unless one is born out from water and out from Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God." He** did not say, "unless one is born <u>in</u> water and born <u>in</u> Spirit." Forcing the concept of being baptized in Spirit (Acts 1:4-5) into the concept of being "born out from water and out from Spirit"" (John 3:5), is like forcing "up" to mean "down." It is self-evident that "out" does not equal "in," after all they represent different directions. The fact we are addressing this fundamental matter shows how far some have gone to justify their false doctrines.

To buttress our point, the phrase *born out from* (**gennēthē ex**) is an ablative marker, identifying source. The ablative is the case of source or origin and is equivalent to the genitive case – genitive of source, which confirms what Jesus said: "unless one is born <u>out from</u> water and <u>out from</u> Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God." The new birth entails being born out from the source of water and being born out from the source of the Spirit, which eradicates the absurd notion that "out" means "in."

Being born **out from** water means being born **out from** regeneration's washing (Titus 3:4-6; Acts 22:16), namely immersion in water for the forgiveness of sins. The source of this teaching is the Holy Spirit, who is the source of all the inspired words of Scripture (2 Tim.3:16-17; Matthew 4:4; John 6:63, 16:13-15; cf. John 3:3-5; Mark 16:16).

Jesus plainly states that it is the Spirit who gives life, but then explains how He gives life. Jesus said: "the words that I speak they are spirit (spiritual – pertaining to the words of the Spirit) and they are life" (John 6:63). The Spirit gives life, but He does so only through the God-Spirited (God-breathed) words of Scripture (2 Tim.3:16-17). When one is born out from Spirit, he is born out from the Spirit's words or teaching (John 5:24, 6:63; James 1:18, 21; 1 Pet.1:22-25; 1 John 3:7-10). Brethren, the argument that says "born out from water and out from Spirit" means baptized in the Holy Spirit is completely without merit and false.

Darrell Allen and I plan to go to The White Rock Fund ((TWRF) report meeting at Webb Chapel Church of Christ this Saturday morning. I will be one of the guest speakers to tell them about the Mission Printing container program that helps us avoid \$1,775,000 per year of U.S. Postage. The last 5 ocean container shipments cost us about \$.40 a pound instead of \$10.00 a pound through the U.S. Postage. Our late Bro. Henry Seidmeyer helped me arrange this good relationship with The White Rock Fund many years ago.
