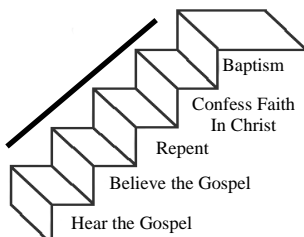

## THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Hear - Romans 10:17  
Believe - John 8:24  
Repent - Acts 17:30  
Confess - Romans 10:10  
Be Baptized - Acts 22:16  
Saved - in Christ (Galatians 3:27)



We encounter a lot of misunderstanding about the church (singular) in society today. The Bible is very clear on this subject!

There is only one church that Christ established and bought; and there is only one church that Christ accepts and sanctions. The Lord built only one church. Jesus said, "I will build my church" (Matt.16:18). The word "church" in this passage is singular. Our Lord did not say "churches", or "one of the churches" or a "church". Rather, He said "church" (singular). Since He has only one church, He has not given us a choice of which one to be a member. So, the doctrine of join the church of your choice is a false doctrine.

The Lord died for only one church. "Feed the church of God, which He hath purchased with His own "blood" (Acts 20:28). Christ "loved the church and gave Himself for it" (singular). Christ did not die for many denominations or for one denomination, but rather He died for His one church.

There was only one church in the days of the apostles. No one ever asked, "of which church are you a member" in the days of the apostles. Why? Because there was only one church, and the protestant denominations were not in existence then. Protestant denominations and Catholic bodies were non-existent in the apostolic age. Therefore, the one church was not made up of all denominations; and it is not today. When the gospel was preached in the first century, such being the seed of the kingdom (Lk. 8:11, only Christians (members of the Lord's church) resulted (Acts 26:28, Rom. 16:16). And since one of God's immutable laws is that seed bear after its kind (Gen.1:11), when the gospel is preached in the 21st century, only the Lord's Church will result. Denominationalism exists because some seed (doctrine) other than the gospel has been peached and planted in the hearts of men.

There is only one body (Eph. 4:4). The body is the church (Eph. 1:22-23). Therefore, there is but one church.

The church is the bride of Christ (Eph. 5:22-23). Christ has only one bride or else He is committing spiritual adultery. Therefore, there is one and only one church. The church is the family of God (I Tim. 3:15). There is only one family of God. Therefore, there is only one church of God. The one church or body is the saved (Eph. 5:23, Acts 2:47). After diligent study, we need to make our calling and election sure. Since there is only one family of God authorized and described in the scriptures, doesn't it behoove us to be a member of that one family where all spiritual blessings are available. Hope to see you assembling with the saints at every meeting time.
