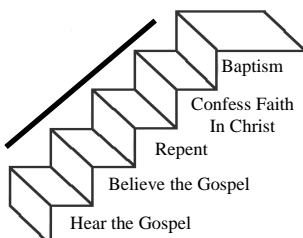

THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Hear - Romans 10:17
Believe - John 8:24
Repent - Acts 17:30
Confess - Romans 10:10

We are anxiously looking forward to Bro. Doug Post starting our work together on September 11. Soon after Bro. Doug's arrival, we will resume Sunday night and Wednesday evening services. More information about this will be released in coming days. In less than two months, we will have a Gospel Meeting with Bro. Jeff Jenkins. Mark the dates October 9-11 on your calendars so that you can plan to fully support our Gospel Meeting by attending and inviting others.

Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ built only one church. Jesus said, "I will build my Church" (Matt.16:18). The word "church" in this passage is singular. Our Lord did not say "Churches", or "one of the churches" or a "church". Rather, He said "church" (singular). Since He has only one church, He has not given us a choice of which one to be a member. So, the doctrine of "join the church of your choice" is a false doctrine.

The Lord died for only one church. "Feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with His own "blood" (Acts 20:28). Christ "loved the church and gave himself for it" (singular). Christ did not die for many denominations or for one denomination, but rather He died for His one church.

There was only one church in the days of the apostles. No one ever asked, "of which church are you a member" in the days of the apostles. Why? Because there was only one church, and the protestant denominations were not in existence then. Protestant denominations and Catholic bodies were non-existent in the apostolic age. Therefore, the one church was not made up of all denominations; and it is not today. When the gospel was preached in the first century, such being the seed of the kingdom (Luke 8:11, only Christians resulted (Acts 26:28, Romans 16:16). And since one of God's immutable laws is that seed bear after its kind (Gen.1:11), when the gospel is preached in the 21st century, only the Lord's Church will result. Denominationalism exists because some seed other than the gospel has been preached and planted in the hearts of men.

There is only one body (Eph. 4:4). The body is the Church (Eph. 1:22-23). Therefore, there is but one church.

The church is the bride of Christ (Eph. 5:22-23). Therefore, there is one and only one church. The Church is the family of God (I Tim. 3:15). There is only one family of God. Therefore, there is only one church of God. The one church or body is the saved (Eph. 5:23, Acts 2:47). After diligent study, we need to make our calling and election sure. All spiritual blessings are available to those that are members of His one church. We each need to ask: Is the church's name you are a member found in the Bible?

Let's remember to pray for our "back-to-schoolers" – our children, parents, teachers, and school staff – that they may have a safe and successful school year. Also, pray for our sick and shut-ins. Have a great week serving the Lord!
