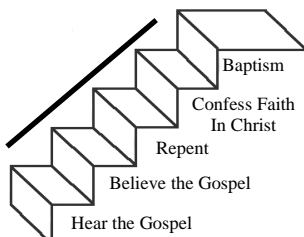

I think we can all agree that the last few years have been turbulent. Politics, a pandemic, shut downs, lock downs, shortages, riots, inflation, increasing degeneracy, an end of one war, a start of another with civility and trust in our systems ever eroding. We of the Faith are not immune to the world's troubles. At times we get extra troubles, because of our faith in the Lord. We may not be able to prevent or avoid the troubles that may come but how we conduct ourselves, that we do. Whether times be easy or hard, I believe we would all do well to examine and have the mindset found in Agur's prayer below.

“Two things I ask of thee, do not refuse me before I die: Keep deception and lies far from me, give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with the food that is my portion, lest I be full and deny Thee and say, “Who is the Lord?” Or lest I be in want and steal and profane the name of my God.” Proverbs 30:7-9

Please note the fervency. There is no mistaking how sincere and important the requests being made are to him (James 5:16). He is humble and admits that he is but mortal and finite needing what only what God can provide. (James 4:10) His thoughts and requests are succinct and non-repetitive. (Matt. 6: 7-8)

His first request was for lies and deceit not to be found anywhere in nor near him. Imagine how blissful life would be without the pain, chaos, distrust, doubt, and confusion brought on by liars, false and frivolous ideas, and words set to distract or derail us from the narrow and difficult path. (Matt. 7:13-20) This request was not of a fleshly but a spiritual desire.

His last request was of a worldly concern but far from having wrong motives (James. 4:3) such as the lust of the eye, lust of the flesh or the vain glories of life. (1 John 2:16). He asked only for his “daily bread” (Matt. 6:11) so as not to be led into temptation. (Matt. 6:13) Perhaps Agur had sinned previously in those manners and sought help never to repeat them. It appears he had searched himself and knew where his weakness lay, humbly seeking help so his actions would bring glory to God. (Matt. 5:16)

Whether the times are good or bad our responsibility to God does not change. Let us strive this week for more fervent, effectual prayers being mindful of those sick of body, grieving lost loved ones, and especially those whose souls are in peril.
