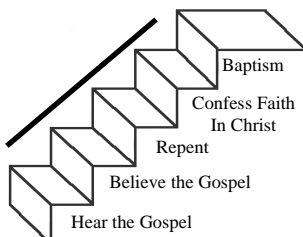

The task is enormous, I give God all the glory for using me, my family and other faithful brethren to carry out this divine mandate. The Mission Printing materials that we are using, preach even when we leave the village or city. We receive calls for follow-up.
