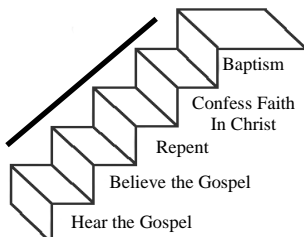

“IT IS WELL WITH MY SOUL” is a well-beloved old hymn. I have noticed whether sitting in the pew or up-front song leading, our congregation steps it up a notch when this song is being sung. I am sure most of us have heard the tragic origin of this hymn before, but it bears repeating as an example of faith, hope, and peace.

Haratio Spafford was a successful lawyer and real estate investor. Prior to the 1871 Great Chicago Fire in which his finances were devastated, his only son died from scarlet fever at the age of four. In November 1873 Mr. Spafford sent his wife and 4 daughters to Europe for a vacation. He would follow a few days later after settling some business. While in route, Mrs. Spafford and the girl’s ship collided with another ship, sinking in just 12 minutes. All four daughters were lost at sea. Upon reaching shore, Mrs. Spafford telegraphed her husband, “Saved alone, what shall I do? While in route to be with his wife, the captain of the ship informed Mr. Spafford when they were in the area where his daughters ship went down. It was on this voyage when he penned the words.

When peace like a river attendeth my way
When sorrows like sea billows roll
Whatever my lot, Thou hast taught me to say
It is well, it is well with my soul
Though Satan should buffet, though trials should come
Let this blest assurance control
That Christ has regarded my helpless estate
And has shed His own blood for my soul
My sin, oh the bliss of this glorious thought
My sin, not in part, but the whole
Is nailed to the cross, and I bear it no more
Praise the Lord, praise the Lord, O my soul!
And Lord, haste the day when my faith shall be sight
The clouds be rolled back as a scroll
The trump shall resound, and the Lord shall descend
Even so, it is well with my soul!
