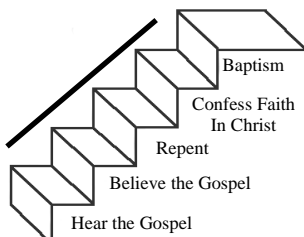

## THE GOSPEL PLAN OF SALVATION

Hear - Romans 10:17  
Believe - John 8:24  
Repent - Acts 17:30

We don't know what the future holds for us. We do know though who holds the future. We are running a race with death (Heb 9:27). Tragedies happen every day. Some are made by man, and others are beyond man's control. Life is like a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away (James 4:14).

Because each of us is allotted our own set amount of time in this life, time is possibly the most important commodity we are given. During a year's time, we each have the same number of hours in a day, days in a week, and weeks in a year. Yet how we use that time varies greatly depending upon what season of life we are in and how we *choose* to spend our time. Because time *is* a limited, the passing of time requires us to use it wisely. Ephesians 5:15-17 admonishes us to walk in wisdom saying, "Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is." While it is important for us to make plans to use our time wisely, James 4:13-17 cautions us not to boast about tomorrow: "Come now, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year there, buy and sell, and make a profit'; whereas you do not know what *will happen* tomorrow. For what *is* your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away. Instead you *ought* to say, 'If the Lord wills, we shall live and do this or that.' But now you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil. Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do *it*, to him it is sin."

We must use the time we are given to prepare ourselves for eternity (Romans 13:11). We must not wait to repent and be baptized (Acts 2:38; 2 Peter 3:9), and we must take every opportunity to share the gospel to those who so desperately need to hear it (Matt 28:19). We must diligently strive to grow a fruitful faith that increases in virtue, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, brotherly kindness, and love (2 Peter 1:5-11); and we must grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:18, 2 Timothy 3:16)

Each of us must ask ourselves: How am I walking? How am I spending my time? Am I using my time in the service of the Lord? Am I carefully looking out for things that may cause me or others to stumble? Am I doing everything I do to the glory of God? 1 Corinthians 15:58 tells us, "Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord." As we read in 2 Corinthians 5:20-21, we are implored to be "reconciled to God. For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him"; and continuing in 2 Corinthians 6:1-2, we are told "today is the day of salvation." James 5:7-11 encourages us to be patient and persevering "until the coming of the Lord ... You have heard of the perseverance of Job and seen the end *intended* by the Lord—that the Lord is very compassionate and merciful."
